

25-Year Limited Residential Stain & Fade Warranty

10-Year Limited Commercial Warranty

Congratulations! Thank you for purchasing products from Integrity Composites LLC. This warranty covers (1) your DuraLifeTM SiestaTM Collection Solid Blends and Hardwood Blends Decking, MVP Decking, fascia board, and Fastenator[®] Clips (2) your DuraLifeTM RailWays[®] Universal Railing products (except Uni-BallTM Connectors, and NiteScapes lighting) (3) your DuraLifeTM Dock Collection and (4) your DuraLifeTM Porch Collection (performance only). While many factors can affect how long your DuraLife decking and railing products will last, this Limited Warranty covers your Duralife decking and railing in the unlikely event that any component contains a manufacturing defect.

What Is Covered By This Limited Warranty Product Performance

Integrity Composites warrants that your DuraLife products will remain free from manufacturing defects that adversely affect its performance during the warranty term and shall not split, splinter, or suffer structural damage from termites.

Stain

Integrity Composites warrants that your DuraLife products will resist permanent staining from food and beverage items including wine, tea, coffee, fruit punch, sodas, ketchup, salad oils, barbecue sauces, mustard and other food or beverage related items that would typically be present on a residential deck, provided that such substances are removed from DuraLife with soap and water or mild household cleaners (excluding bleach) after no more than one (1) week of exposure of the substances to the product surface.

Integrity Composites does not warrant DuraLife products as stain-proof, and does not warrant stain resistance resulting from spilled or otherwise applied food and beverage substances which are not properly cleaned as provided above within one (1) week of exposure.

Fade

Integrity Composites warrants that your DuraLife products will resist color change from light and weathering exposure as measured by color change in excess of 5 Delta E (CIE) during the warranty term. DuraLife products are designed to be fade resistant, but not fade proof.

(NOTE: DuraLifeTM Porch and RailWays[®] Universal Railing products are solely covered under the 25 year performance warranty, and are NOT covered under the 25 year stain & fade warranty.)

Who Is Covered By This Limited Warranty

This warranty is given to the original purchaser, residential or commercial as the case may be. For the purpose of this warranty, a 'residential purchaser' shall refer to individual residential homeowner and a 'commercial purchaser' shall refer to any purchaser other than a residential purchaser.

This limited warranty may be transferred one time by the residential purchaser only. The second owner must notify Integrity Composites in writing within 60 days after the property transfer for warranty coverage to be transferred. (Other than this one transfer, this warranty may not be transferred or assigned, directly or indirectly.) If the transfer takes place within the first five years, the second owner has the same coverage as the original owner. If the transfer takes place after the initial five year period, the length of this warranty shall be reduced to the two-year period after ownership changes but otherwise has the same coverage as the original owner.

Your Sole And Exclusive Remedy

Even if your claim is on components of your DuraLife products other than the deck itself, the warranty term and remedy are based on which decking product was installed. Integrity Composites will provide replacement DuraLife products, or their reasonable cost, at Integrity Composite's sole option, necessary to repair your DuraLife products.

Limitations On Coverage

Integrity Composites will NOT compensate you for:

- (1) Damages resulting from anything other than an inherent manufacturing defect in your DuraLife products such as:
 - (a) application of your DuraLife product not in strict accordance with Integrity Composites' printed application instructions or building codes, or in an application not recommended by Integrity Composites if the improper installation was the cause of the damage.
 - (b) settlement, movement, or defects in the building, foundation, supporting structure, or ground where the DuraLife product was applied.
 - (c) inadequate ventilation under your DuraLife product.
- (2) Damages resulting from causes beyond normal wear and tear, such as:
 - (a) acts of God, such as earthquakes, flooding, lightning, hail, hurricanes, tornadoes, or windstorms.
 - (b) impact of foreign objects or traffic on your DuraLife product.
 - (c) improper storage or handling of your DuraLife product.
 - (d) any exposure to or application of paints or any improper cleaning solutions, coatings, liquid chemicals, or exposure to environmental conditions (such as air pollution or fungus, mold, lichen or algae, or other contaminants).
 - (e) mechanical damage, such as scuffing or scratching.
- (3) Shading, or variations in the color of your DuraLife decking and railing product including discoloration caused by normal weathering, chipping, scratching, or fading of the paint on any metal component. NOTE: Color variation occurs naturally during the manufacturing process and should be expected. When exposed to the elements, color variation due to weathering may be uneven because of exposure to different amounts of sunlight.
- (4) Integrity Composites shall not be responsible for, costs and expenses incurred with respect to the removal of any defective DuraLife products or installation of replacement materials.
- (5) Damage to the interior or exterior of any building, including, but not limited to, mold growth.
- (6) Materials not covered by the stain resistant warranty include abrasive compounds of acidic or basic pH, strong solvents, oil based paints or stains, metallic rust and other abnormal residential deck use item. Including for example, but not limited to, fungicides, bactericides, bio cides, plant food, pet or human stains such as vomit, blood, urine or feces.
 - (a) exposure to heat greater than 250 degrees F
 - (b) surface damages or punctures.
 - (c) if paint or any other coating has been applied.
 - (d) not properly cleaned within one (1) week of exposure to food/beverage.

Other Limitations And Conditions

Integrity Composites reserves the right to discontinue or modify its DuraLife decking and railing products, including the colors available, so any replacement DuraLife decking and railing products may not be an exact match for the DuraLife decking and railing products installed. Even if Integrity Composites does not modify a color, replacement DuraLife decking and railing products may not match your original DuraLife decking and railing products due to normal weathering.

Claims: What You Must Do

Before filing a stain claim with Integrity Composites, residential purchaser must clean the deck within one (1) week stain causing item makes contact with the deck, and also have the deck professionally cleaned at the residential purchaser's expense. If the deck still is not satisfactory, within thirty (30) days of professional cleaning file a claim. Pictures, proof of purchase, and proof of compliance above must be included for filing a stain claim.

To file a claim, you must send a notice in writing, together with proof of purchase to establish that you are the

original owner (or proof of transfer if the second owner has properly transferred coverage), proof of application date, and a description and pictures of the alleged defect, to: Integrity Composites, 8 Morin Street, Biddeford, ME 04005, within 30 days after your discovery of the alleged defect. NOTE: Notice to your contractor, dealer, or home builder is NOT notice to Integrity Composites. Within a reasonable time after proper notification, Integrity Composites will evaluate your claim and resolve it in accordance with this Warranty. If you replace your DuraLife decking and railing products before Integrity Composites has an opportunity to evaluate your claim, your claim may be denied. You should have this warranty certificate signed and dated by your contractor, dealer, or home builder to help establish proof of purchase and related information. You should retain this warranty for your records in the event that you need to file a claim.

If the residential DuraLife product owner makes a valid warranty claim hereunder during years eleven (11) through twenty-five (25) after the original purchase, then the residential DuraLife product owner's recovery will be prorated as indicated below. If Integrity Composites is providing replacement materials, it may elect to replace the percentage listed below of the purchase price of boards otherwise meeting the requirements for a claim.

Sole and Exclusive Warranty

THIS WARRANTY IS EXCLUSIVE AND REPLACES ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, CONDITIONS, REPRESENTATIONS, AND GUARANTEES, WHETHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, WHETHER BY STATUTE, AT LAW OR IN EQUITY, INCLUDING THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. This written warranty is your exclusive warranty from Integrity Composites and represents the SOLE REMEDY available to any owner of DuraLife products. Integrity Composites makes NO OTHER REPRESENTATIONS, CONDITION, GUARANTEE, OR WARRANTY of any kind other than that stated herein. Integrity Composites WILL NOT BE LIABLE IN ANY EVENT FOR CONSEQUENTIAL, PUNITIVE, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, OR OTHER SIMILAR DAMAGES OF ANY KIND, including DAMAGE TO THE INTERIOR OR EXTERIOR OF ANY BUILDING, whether for breach of this warranty, negligence, strict liability in tort, or for any other cause. Some jurisdictions do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above exclusions or limitations may not apply to you.

Effectiveness

This Limited Warranty will not take effect unless all eligibility requirements have been satisfied and your decking contractor has been paid in full.

Effective Date: This 25 Year Stain & Fade Limited Warranty is in effect for DuraLife products installed after March 15, 2012.
